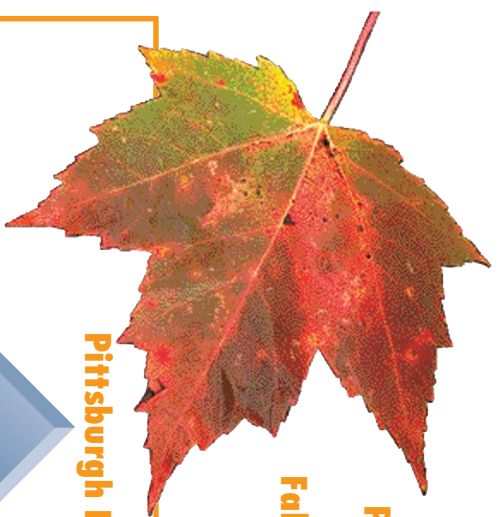

#### JOB SITE SAFETY

#### Excavation Safety and Loss Prevention Safety

#### Working Around Mixing Trucks

Heavy equipment on a residential jobsite boils down to just a handful of types. Mixing trucks are perhaps one of the most frequent problems waiting to happen if crews are not educated on how to interact with the drivers and prepare the site for their arrival.

#### Crane Safety for Wall Contractors

#### Pumping Safety
