



**NAHB/N.O.D. DISABILITY INITIATIVE AWARD
APPLICATION FORM FOR RECOGNITION AWARD**

Due by Tuesday, September 2, 2008

Description: The National Association of Home Builders and the National Housing Endowment, in cooperation with the National Partnership Program of the National Organization on Disability (N.O.D.), are pleased to co-sponsor the NAHB/N.O.D Disability Initiative Recognition Award. The award will be given to a Home Builders Association that has successfully engaged its members in a model project to enhance the lives of persons with disabilities by expanding their participation and involvement in community life and activities.

The Home Builders Association selected as the recipient of the 2008 NAHB/NOD Disability Initiative Award will receive \$1,000, made possible through a grant from the National Housing Endowment. The Award will be presented at the NAHB Board Meeting at the International Builders Show in January 2009.

Procedure: Submit the enclosed application form with any supplemental materials by September 2, 2008.

Criteria: The project must demonstrate an awareness of disability issues as an organization, outreach to persons with disabilities, and the positive impact of the project on people with disabilities. Past award-winning projects are ineligible to participate and their applications will not be considered.

Instructions: Describe what your Home Builders Association or builder member has done to expand the participation of persons with disabilities in community life and activities. Give specifics. Please use the form attached. Here are some questions to guide your entry description:

- What is the title of the project?
- What need did the local HBA address?
- Where was the project conducted?
- Approximately how many member volunteer hours were spent?
- How many members were involved?
- How many other people were involved?
- Were any people with disabilities involved in planning or implementing the project?
- What was the result, e.g. goals accomplished, changes that occurred, impact on those with disabilities, impact on the community as a whole?
- How did it enhance the lives of those with disabilities by helping them to participate in community activities?
- Approximately how many people were reached?
- Does the project continue? How?
- Does the project have potential for replication?
- Did the project get publicity?
- List any key partnerships established or enhanced by conducting the project.
